A new offering of the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED 2009 v3 is the Green Associate (GA) credential. To pass the GBCI exam that awards this professional accreditation, it requires an understanding of LEED's core concepts and strategies, but it does not require the hands-on technical knowledge that, for example, architects and engineers bring to the actual construction or renovation of a building.

The Green Associate is now designated a Tier 1 accreditation and is the only credential available in this tier. At present, the multiple-choice test is expected to take up to two hours.

The LEED Green Associate credential will make you more marketable to employers and clients, as it will confirm your knowledge about the green building industry, and your commitment to sustainability.
